Students Set for Success



Grants available to boost student success

A \$2 million Set for Success pilot program announced yesterday aims to boost outcomes for students of government-funded training, including apprentices and trainees.

Training providers that deliver Queensland Government-funded training, known as Skills Assure Suppliers (SAS), can apply for funding to develop and trial high-quality, innovative and scalable initiatives to support student completions.

Grants of up to \$250,000 are available for initiatives that assist Queenslanders who experience barriers to completing their training, as well as for in-demand industry qualifications.

Applicants are encouraged to partner with employers, peak bodies, industry associations or specialist service providers in developing initiatives that deliver great training for good, local jobs in communities across the state.

The pilot program is an initiative of the Queensland Skills Strategy, which is supporting students to complete their training and be set for success in the workforce – securing a pipeline of skills for the state's economy into the future.

Set for Success applications opened yesterday (1 August 2024) and will close 30 August 2024.
