

## Government-funded VET Outcomes

### Region

- A total of 89,015 qualifications were completed in the government-funded vocational education and training (VET) system during 2023-24.
- Qualification completions in Far North Queensland had the highest absolute increase, up 19.2 per cent (or 1,004) between 2019-20 and 2023-24.
- In 2023-24, more than 70 per cent of qualification completions were awarded in South East (26.5 per cent), Metropolitan (25.3 per cent) and North Coast (21.0 per cent).
