

# Government-funded VET Outcomes

## Australian Qualifications Framework

- A total of 89,015 qualifications were completed in the government-funded vocational education and training (VET) system during 2023-24.
- Qualification completions increased between 2019-20 and 2023-24 in Certificate I and II by 10,760 (or 42.9 per cent) , Diploma and above by 1,930 (or 32.8 per cent) and Certificate IV by 410 (or 5 per cent).
- In 2023-24, 41.3 per cent of all qualification completions were in Certificate III programs, followed by 40.2 per cent in Certificate I and II programs.
