Are you a work ready migrant, refugee or international student struggling to get into the workforce?

The Diverse Queensland Workforce program represents the Queensland Government's commitment to an inclusive and diverse workforce and ensures individuals from culturally diverse backgrounds are supported to participate in the economy.

Local not-for-profit organisations are funded in key locations to provide a one-stop-shop or hub that offers client-centred services to increase employment opportunities for work ready migrants, refugees and international students.

What's on offer?

Your assistance package can include:

- ✓ 'soft' or 'enterprise' skills to promote job mobility
- ✓ career advice, job search techniques and job readiness skills
- ✓ nationally recognised training
- ✓ work experience opportunities
- ✓ health and wellbeing support
- ✓ vocational English for workplace readiness
- ✓ referral to other services as necessary (e.g. Queensland Overseas Qualification Unit and relevant professional bodies)
- ✓ networking opportunities with local employers
- ✓ career coaching and mentoring
- ✓ post-employment support

Am I eligible?

Are you:

- ✓ a work ready migrant or refugee?
- ✓ an international student aged 18 or older?

If you answered yes and are looking to use your existing qualifications and skills, you may be eligible to participate.

What does it cost?

The assistance is provided to participants at no cost.
