Why Share Your Story?

We love to hear about project achievements or participant success stories. Sharing your story helps showcase the impact of Skilling Queenslanders for Work (SQW) on people, communities, and organisations. These stories may be featured in reports, newsletters, or other communications to highlight your organisation's role in delivering real outcomes for Queenslanders.

What Makes a Good Story?

Your story can focus on:

- A Participant's Journey: Share how a participant benefited from your project. Highlight their challenges, progress, and achievements (e.g. training completed, employment secured, or personal growth).
- **Project Milestones:** Celebrate significant project achievements, like works completed, community engagement highlights, or partnerships developed.

Tips for Writing Your Story

To create a compelling story, please include:

Participant Stories:

- Background: Who they are, why they joined your project, and their circumstances before joining.
- Support: Assistance provided (e.g. training, licences, personalised support).
- Progress: Skills developed, personal growth, and other experiences.
- Outcomes: Employment (include job details), further studies, or other accomplishments.
- Feedback: A quote from the participant, their employer, or project staff.

Project Stories:

- Background: How the project started (e.g. partnerships with councils or community groups).
- Support: Contributions from partners (e.g. donated materials, workshops, work experience).
- Milestones: Significant achievements (e.g. completed works, partnerships, successful events).
- Outcomes: Benefits to the community, participants, or your organisation.
- Feedback: A quote from participants, project partners, or team members.

Include Visuals

High-quality photos or videos strengthen your story. Don't forget to get signed <u>Queensland Government</u> <u>Film/Photo Consent Forms</u> for anyone featured. Acceptable file types are JPEG or JFIF between 3-5MB in size.

How to Submit
